What we are learning:

Mental Health and Well-being

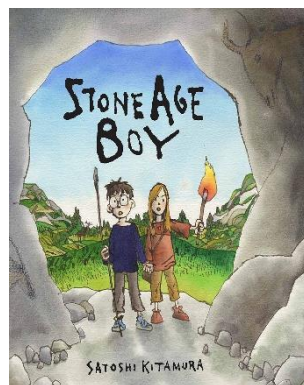
One of our greatest priorities this term is to support children in school and ensure they are feeling safe and well. We will be focusing on road safety and how we can protect each other when travelling.

Children's mental health will be supported through self-esteem activities and learning how to manage emotions in accordance with our RESPECT values.

Writing

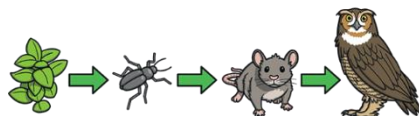
We are using the story Stone Age Boy this half term which is about a boy who goes on an adventure through the Stone Age. The children will learn writing techniques each week to develop their narrative skills. Children will create a new Iron Age based adventure for their own version of the story.

We are using FANTASTICS, Boomtastics and Grammaristics to help us write ambitious sentences.



R.E

Children will continue to learn about the main beliefs of different religions this half term, including Christianity, Hinduism, Islam and Sikhism. Children will also look at the similarities and differences of these religions.



Maths

This term we will be prioritising the children's fluency skills in maths to prepare them for their learning for this academic year.

Place Value

We will continue to work on our place value skills by looking into ordering and comparing numbers up to 10,000.

Four Operations

Children will be learning methods and working through fluency, reasoning and problem-solving questions, which include the four operations of Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division. Children will be using pictorial and practical resources to support them in their learning before answering questions using digits.

To improve fluency, we will continue working through the **99 club**. Children will practise their Club level in school but can also practise at home using TTRockstars, Maths Shed or the downloadable practice sheets.

History

This half term we are learning about the Stone and Iron Ages. We will learn about settlements, wildlife and tools within these eras. Children will also learn about the roles people had in Stone and Iron age society and compare them to each other.

PE

In PE this term children will be enjoying opportunities to learn about co-ordination through dance. We are also learning about basketball and using this sport to help improve ball skills.

Music

During music lessons this half term the children will be singing in harmony, and learning to play a song based on the song Three Little Birds.

Science

This half term children will be designing and conducting an experiment based on teeth erosion. They will also be studying food chains and food webs and learning the scientific vocabulary needed to create their own.
