Special Needs...

We have started to develop our Special Needs Team further this term. There are increasing number of children with SEND needs in our school and so we are looking at how we can continue to develop our support for these children even more. These plans will continue into 2024/2025.

Parental engagement in school...

We are continuing to review school events that parents are invited to and are trying to give as much notice as possible. As we go through this year, we are looking at events that can be put at different times or using online methods as well as face-to-face to help working parents.

After-school Clubs...

Some new and different clubs are being trialled this year. We want to continue to revise how many clubs we offer and which children are taking part in them. We will look at which clubs our children attend regularly and which other clubs we might be able to offer in the future.
