### Attendance

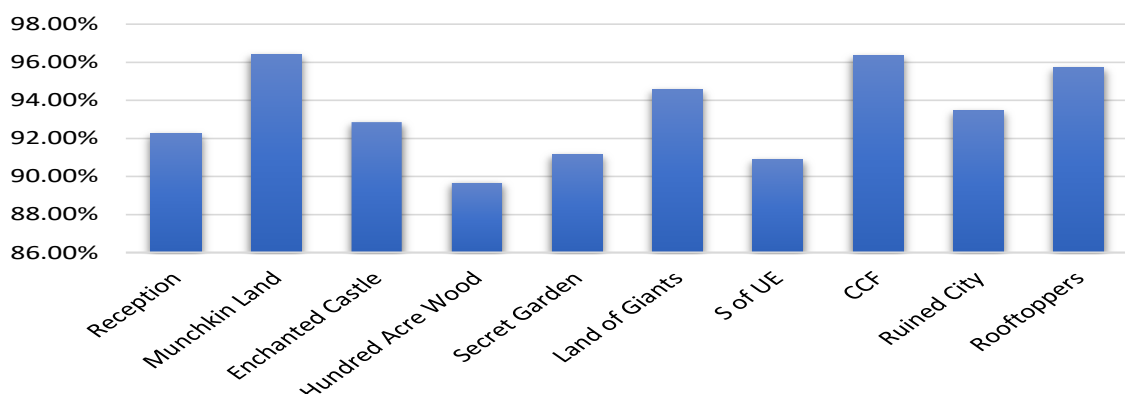
Last week, our whole school attendance was 95.9%. This week, Munchkin Land has the best attendance, with an impressive **96.43%. WELL DONE!!**
