
Alternatively, if you send a message with the book title, ISBN code, author to our office team, they will send these requests directly to the company as well.




Land of Giant's best moment of the term was World Book Day! The children wore some amazing costumes and talked about their favourite stories.

In Charlie's Chocolate Factory, we have enjoyed our Science learning in Fantasy phase, experimenting with materials their different properties.












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Ruined City's magic moment this half term was using the book 'Leaf' to write two contrasting letters as an upset animal!


Mobile Phones and Photographs whilst on the school site
