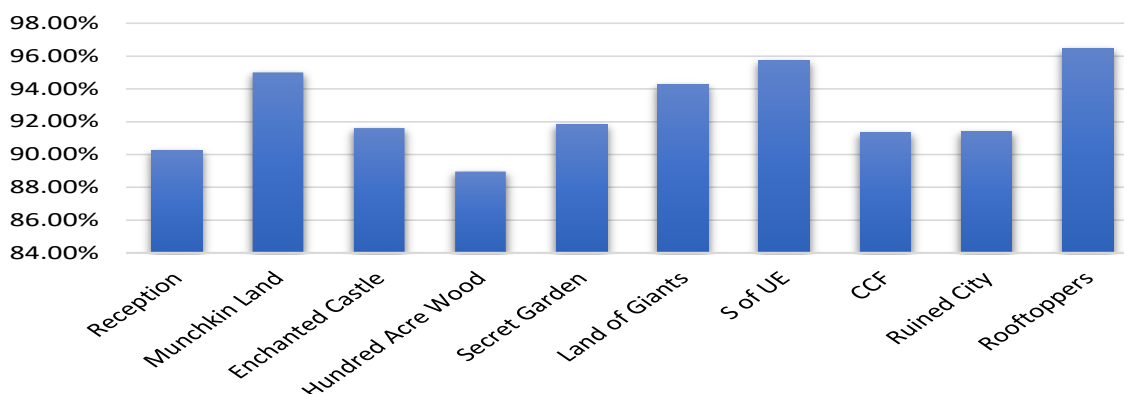
Proposed change to times of the school day
