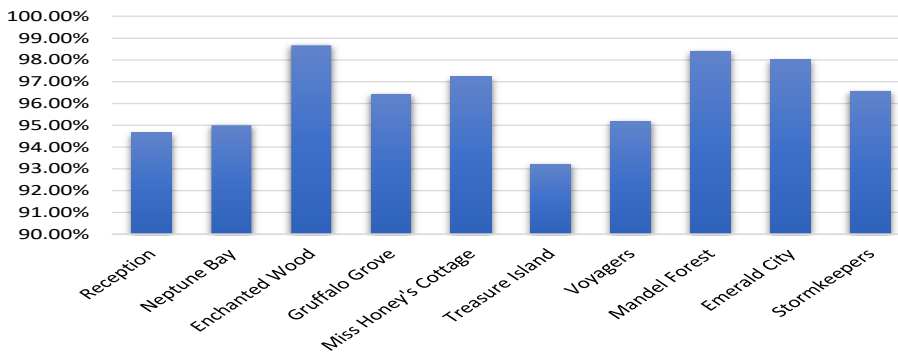
Personal Data
