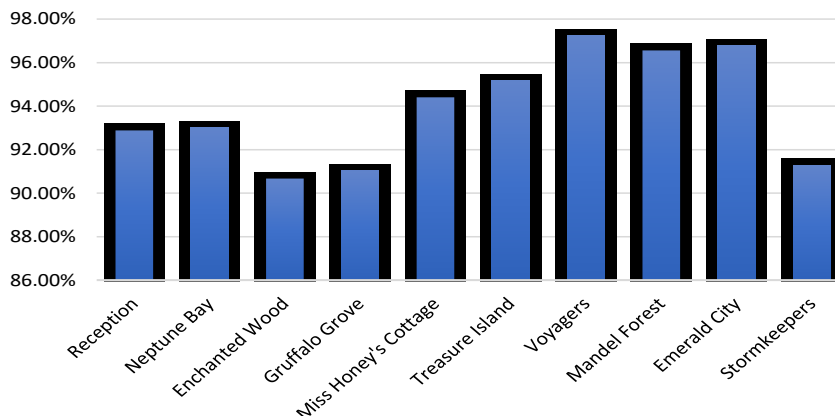
FREE Breakfast – Friday 24th Oct
