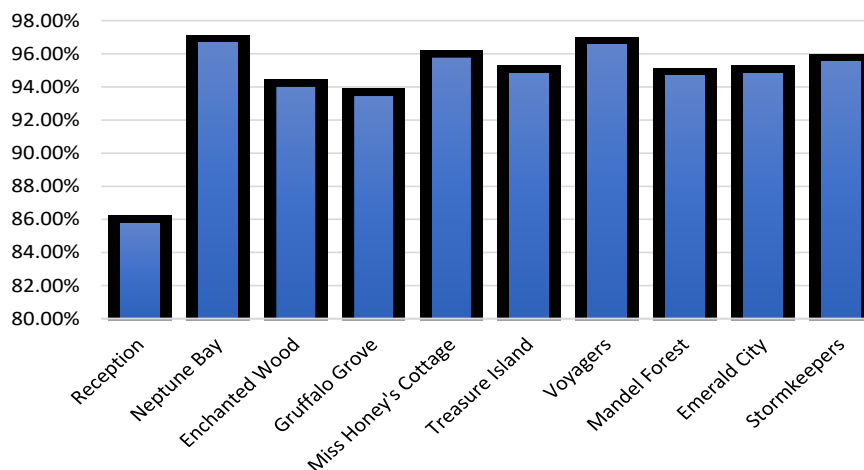
This partnership between home and school is key. There will be lots more opportunities for you to be involved next half-term.
