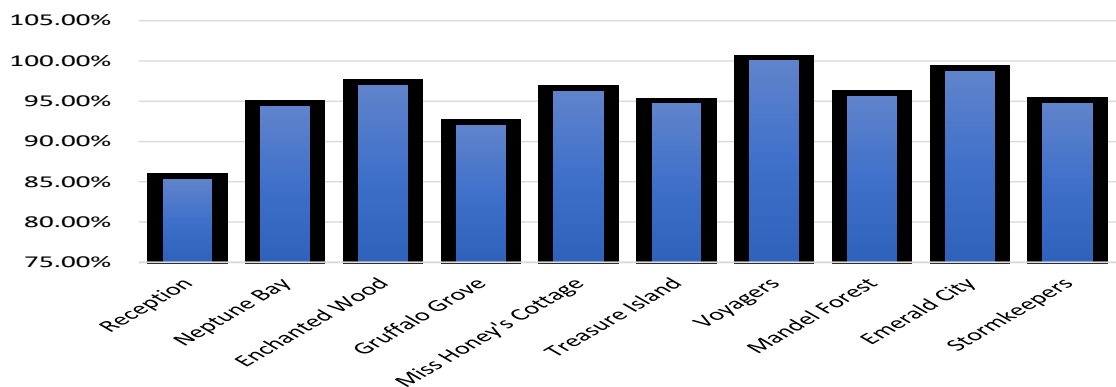
Road Safety
