Have a lovely weekend and we look forward to welcoming you to school over the next few weeks for our Christmas concerts.

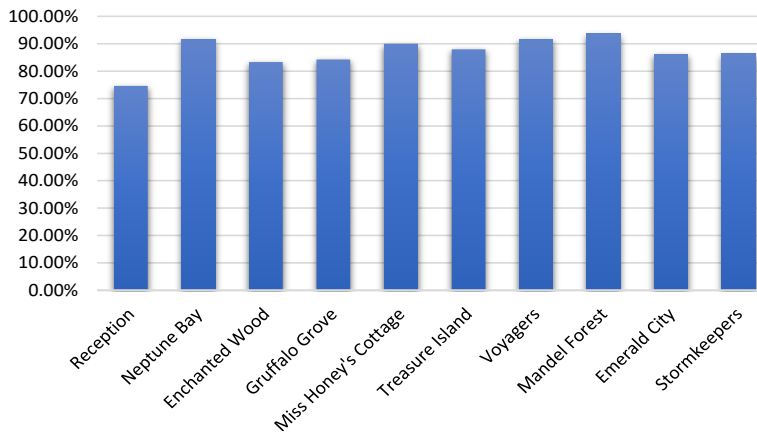
Coundon Hall Park
