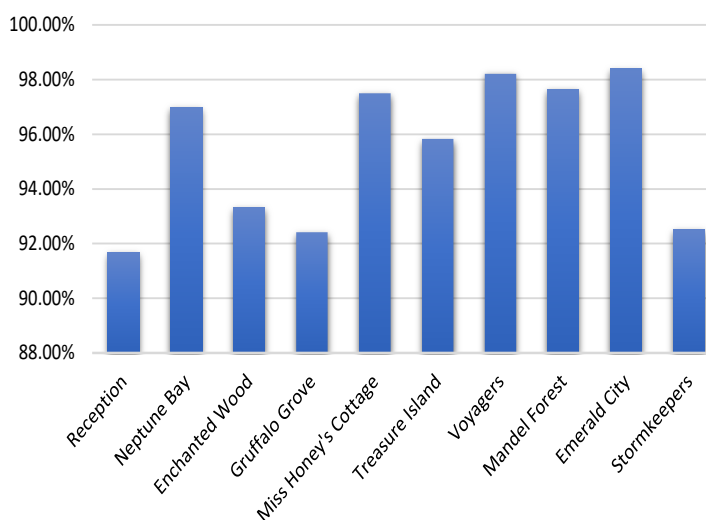

Well done to Emerald City for achieving 98.39% attendance this week, what a way to start this half term! In KS1, Neptune Bay got runner up best attendance with 96.98%.
