Parking and road safety

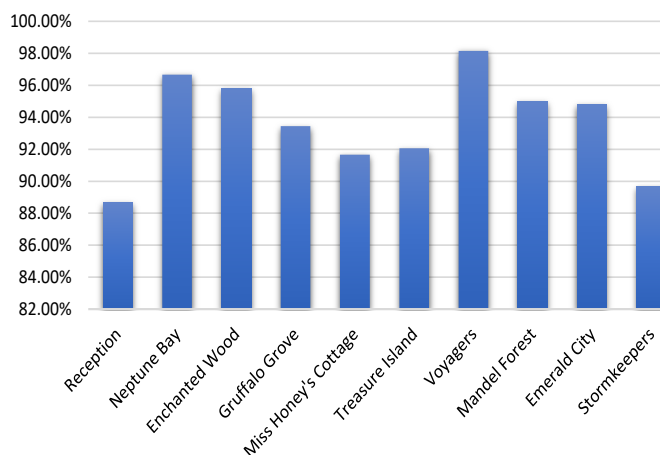
