The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection, Local Authority, Trust and School Risk assessments;
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;
- Provide each child with their own resources and walled work pack, which they will keep for their own use when they are in school.
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays any of the symptoms of COVID-19;
- Organise staff and children into learning 'bubbles' with other family members, who will learn, eat and play together and stay within designated classrooms and outside areas.
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' test positive for COVID-19, as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days.
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlines in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, text, email and via the school website.
- Continue to offer resources, ideas and learning support for our families with their child's home learning.

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know the results as soon as possible via telephone;
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately, get them tested and I will let the school know the results as soon as possible via telephone;
- On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules and follow designated route ways in school, including removing and sealing a worn mask in a bag/container.
- When dropping off and picking up my child, I will strictly stick to the allocated timings and entry and exit location, as specified by the school;
- I will ensure that my child wears newly clean clothing each day, to reduce the risk of any cross contamination, following the uniform expectations published.
- My child will only bring in their lunch and two water bottles (for morning and afternoon) into school and will not bring in any additional unnecessary items;
- To safeguard our school community, I will not be allowed on to the school site and will wait at a safe social distance at my child's allocated collection point;
- I will use the 'Studybugs' or 'Parent Mail' app, telephone or email as my primary approach when contacting the school;
- I will support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this time;
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I will inform the school of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details immediately.
- If my child is deemed unsafe, he or she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.

I will do my best to:

- Follow the school and 'bubble' rules that keep me safe.
- Tell an adult straight away if I feel unwell;
- Only bring a lunchbox and two water bottles to school and not bring any other things into school from home, or take anything home from school;
- Only use the equipment in my pack.
- Not mix with any other 'bubbles' of children within school.
- Only enter and exit the school building at the designated time and gate;
- Follow the catch it-bin it-kill it rules, coughing and sneezing into my elbow or a tissue.
- Wash or sanitize my hands as soon as I go into school and at regular times throughout the school day, when asked to by an adult.
- When washing my hands, use soap and water for 20 seconds.
- Follow the rules at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others.
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
